Ranking is made taking into account:

- 1) Max number of total medals of a Nation;
- 2) In the event of a tie, Nations are ranked by the max number of total gold medals;
- 3) In the event of a tie of gold medals, Nations are ranked by the max number of total silver medals;
- 4) If a tie still exists, Nations are ranked considering that team medals prevail over individual medals;
- 5) If all the selective factors are equal, Nations are ranked equal.
