Upon a unanimous decision of the FIPSed Steering Committee, the results achieved in 2021 do not count for rankings.

From 1964 until 1973 included, Championships took place in one single leg - Nation ranking was made based on minimum total penalties of the 5 anglers of each Nation in their respective sectors and then on maximum total score of the 5 anglers of each Nation in their respective sectors. Individual ranking was made based on maximum score obtained by each angler, considering the full venue as a single sector, without bearing in mind penalties he gained in his respective sector.

From 1974 until 1987 included, Championships took place in two days: the first day dedicated to the Nation competition and the second day to the individual competition - Nation ranking was done on the Saturday competition results, based on minimum total penalties of the 5 anglers of each Nation in their respective sectors and then on maximum total score of the 5 anglers of each Nation in their respective sectors. Individual ranking was done on the Sunday competition results. This competition was held in one single sector by a selected number of competitors (i.e. the first 4 competitors classified in each of the 5 sectors of the Saturday competition plus one angler per Nation, selected by the relevant Coach). Individual ranking was made based on maximum score of each angler.

From 1988 until now, both Nations and individual competitions are organized on 2 legs. Nation and individual rankings are made considering the sum of the results of 2 legs, on the basis of minimum total penalties of the 5 anglers of each Nation in their respective sectors, for Nation ranking, and of minimum total penalties of each angler in his respective sectors, for individual ranking. In the event of a tie, Nation and individual rankings are then made on the basis of maximum total weight obtained by the 5 anglers of each Nation in their respective sectors, for Nation ranking, or by each angler in his respective sectors, for individual ranking.

From 1964 until 1968 included, competitors' score was calculated considering 5 points per fish plus 1 point per gram.

From 1969 until 1978 included, competitors' score was calculated considering 1 point per fish plus 1 point per gram.

From 1979 until now, no points are attributed to number of fish: competitors' score is calculated considering only 1 point per gram.
